Odaininc? are raising sheep (50 at the moment) and pigs (10 at the moment). Apart from that, the Association works with the agricultural crop: wheat, corn, oat, etc.

Indirect beneficiaries.

The reorganization of the farm will lead to the creation of the new job places: women will be involved in taking care of animals, even elderly will have the possibility to take part in the project since products processing could be fulfilled by less working population. Apart from the above, a certain amount of the processed products will be sold to the poorest with a reduced price.
